Rehabilitation and Aged Care Services offers comprehensive training in Geriatric Medicine including Sub-Acute Geriatric Medicine, Geriatric and Acute Rehabilitation, Transition Care, Consultation and Liaison Service, Ortho-Geriatrics, Movement Disorders, Domiciliary Assessments, Residential In-Reach, Palliative Care, Aged Psychiatry and Multidisciplinary Specialist Clinics (Pain, Memory, Falls & Balance, Continence and Movement Disorders). In 2012 a rural rotation was offered for the first time. Positions are individually tailored to maximise training opportunities. There is a strong emphasis on education and training with sessions throughout the week, including a full afternoon for advanced training education every week. The compulsory five (5) hours training time is scheduled into the roster and timetable for each position. Job share arrangements will be considered.</p>
